A **Corporate First Response Program** within Austin/Travis County Emergency Medical Services (A/TC-EMS) is designed for large campuses within A/TC-EMS's service area. The programs are designed to augment the traditional first responders who's purpose it is to assist the A/TC-EMS Paramedics when they arrive on scene. In central Austin the traditional first responder is the Austin Fire Department. There are two fire stations near campus: 30th Street and Cedar Street and MLK Boulevard and Nueces Street. There is also an A/TC-EMS station near the equivalent of 14th Street and Hospital Dr.

**Our desired purpose** as a corporate first response program is to offer stand by EMS service at events on the UT campus.

We also provide an **Emergency Medical Technician course** at the Basic level through our education program. Through this Department of State Health Services approved course, you will learn the necessary skills to provide patient care at the basic life support level as well as upon successful completion have the ability to take a national registry exam to be able to practice in most states.
