 - a. LHSEMS is a student-led organization that responds to all medical emergencies on the University of Texas at Austin campus
 - b. Every responder is a certified responder (Emergency Care Attendant or higher) with the State of Texas
 - c. LHSEMS is currently a Basic Life Support (BLS) service, meaning that the responders are trained to restore and/or maintain someone's life without advanced medications.
 - d. LHSEMS, in addition to emergency response, provides stand-by services at events on the UT Campus, including but not limited to: football games, basketball games, 40 Acers fest, fun-runs, etc.
 - e. LHSEMS is an agency within student government
 - f. LHSEMS operates under the auspices of Austin-Travis County EMS as a Corporate First Responder Organization. Many large companies like Dell, IBM, TXDHS, and many others also have Corporate First Response Organizations. All medical direction is provided by the medical director of Austin-Travis County EMS, Dr. Edward Racht.
